Poso Creek IRWM Plan Implementation Activity and Correspondence for January – March 2020

PLAN UPDATE

• GEI has submitted the 2019 Plan Update to DWR in August for a compliance review regarding DWR IRWM Plan Guidelines. A public access link was sent to DWR on January 22, 2020 and will need to be posted by DWR to their site for 30-day public comment period. IRWM Plan Adoption will take place following comment period.

OUTREACH/DAC's

- Tulare-Kern Funding Area DAC Involvement Program (TKFA DACIP) Project Advisory Committee (PAC). PAC Meetings are held bi-monthly. The PAC has vetted and approved all projects submitted for allocated regional and competitive funds. Stephanie H. and Christine G. are actively participating in the meetings on behalf of the Poso Creek IRWM/DACs. GEI has finalized all contracts with Tulare County for grant awards and will be attending the next meeting on March 19th.
- IRWM Roundtable of Regions Statewide Roundtable meetings are held quarterly. The focus is currently on securing future funding for the IRWM program. Per the Group's approval, GEI submitted support on a statewide letter drafted by the Roundtable to the legislature on a future water bond to allocate \$1 billion to IRWM and other similar programs. GEI will continue to represent the Group interests at these meetings.

PROJECTS/FUNDING

- Prop 1 DACIP Funding: \$3.4M; ~\$250K project funding per IRWM has been allocated through the TKFA DACIP PAC. The allocated \$250K has been divvied up for projects within the Poso Creek IRWM Region to support project development activities and supply application cost reimbursement for projects submitted for Prop 1 Round 1 IRWM Implementation Grant funding. No projects were submitted for the additional \$250K pot of competitive funds.
- The following pages lists status of existing grant awards, agreements, and applications. Two funding applications were awarded in June and a third in July; several awards from 2018 and 2019 were signed into funding agreements in September. Several grant applications were submitted between the months of October and December. One funding application was awarded in February.

• Prop 1 Round 1IRWM grant submission for Poso Creek IRWM Group was submitted to DWR on Sept 6, 2019. DWR has released the recommended funding list for the Tulare Kern Funding Area (TKFA). The Poso Creek IRWM proposal scored the highest overall; therefore, received a majority of the approximately \$12.7m allocated, with approximately \$5.4m awarded for DAC and General Implementation Projects. GEI submitted a comment letter on behalf of the Group in support of DWR's recommended funding for the Poso Creek Region and will be submitted additionally documentation in mi-March to comply with any outstanding eligibility requirements.
